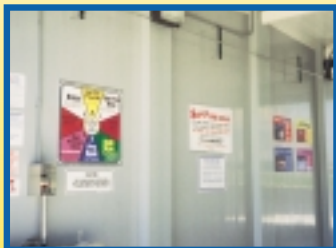

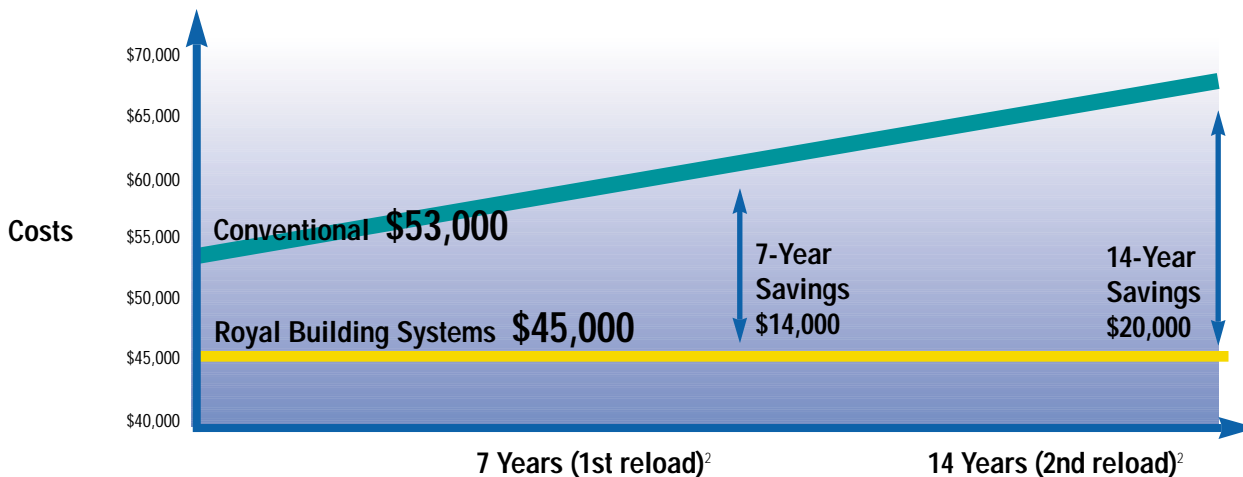

1. For comparison purposes, initial construction is based on a 27' x 42' automatic bay car wash with utility room (Royal Vehicle Wash Model 210CW). Cost for CMU construction is based on the following: built to code by qualified contractor, interior and exterior coated with a minimum of 2 coats of quality epoxy paint. The initial costs and maintenance costs are estimates only; actual costs may vary depending on contractor, location of project, final design, finishes, etc.

2. Seven years is the typical reload cycle at which time the interior of the CMU vehicle wash is cleaned and finished with FRP panel, prior to the new equipment being reloaded. The cost of cleaning and refinishing is approximately \$6,000.
